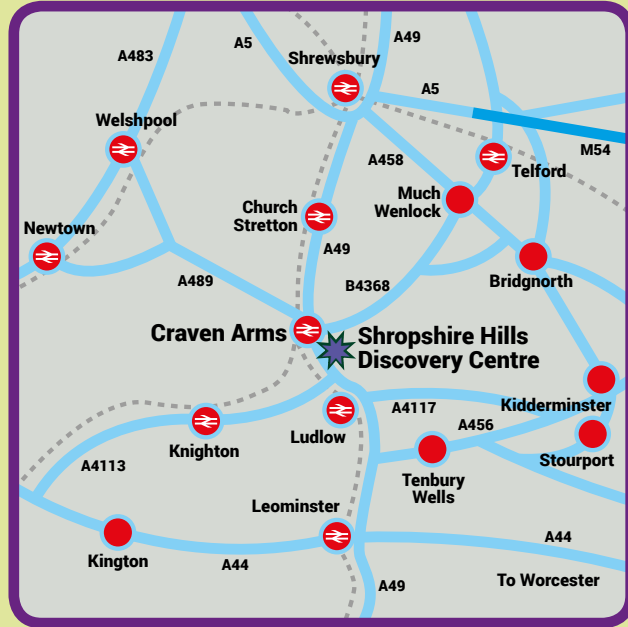


How to Find Us
